



How to Use

Place 4 soap nuts in the small muslin bag, tie it closed, and throw it into the drum of your washing machine. You can reuse this batch for 4 to 6 loads of laundry. No need to remove the soap nuts for the rinse cycle. They act as a fabric softener as well. The soap nuts will be mushy and gray when they are ready to be composted. Alternatively, you can use 3 tbsp of soap nuts liquid detergent per large load of laundry.

To Make Soap Nuts Liquid

Boil 10-12 whole soap nuts with 6 cups of water for 30 minutes. When it is boiled down, you will have about 4 cups of liquid detergent. It is better to make the liquid in smaller batches as it has no preservatives and can spoil.

Cleaning Information...

All Purpose Cleaner

Keep the liquid in a spray bottle and use to clean the bathroom, kitchen, floors etc.

Steam Cleaning Spot Treatment

Add 3 tbsp to 4 qt hot water and use in a portable steam cleaner.

Window and Glass Cleaner

Fill a 1 qt spray bottle with water, 1 tbsp vinegar and 1 Tbsp soap nuts liquid.

In the Dishwasher

Place a muslin bag with 4 soap nuts into your silverware basket. Replace soap nuts when they are grey and mushy.
